



Uniform and Grooming Policy - Addendum

Cardijn College Uniform & Grooming Requirements

At all times, students are ambassadors of the school and are expected to wear the uniform in a way that presents a positive face of Cardijn College.

The following uniform requirements apply to all campuses.

Jewellery

In general terms, jewellery and body piercing is not permitted to be worn with the school uniform.

1. Students may wear one plain, small pair of gold, silver, pearl, diamond sleepers or studs, in the lower lobe only.
2. Watches are permitted.
3. One simple ring, e.g., signet ring, may be worn.
4. A necklace and/or chain will be permitted only when they are part of a cross, or other religious symbolic jewellery.
5. No other visible jewellery is permitted.
6. Facial/Body piercings are not permitted (and students are not permitted to wear band aids to cover piercings).
7. Multiple studs and larger/ornate earrings are not permitted.

Hair and Grooming

Hair for all students, must be clean, neat and well-groomed at all times.

Cuts and styles which, in the opinion of the College, are extreme, or attract attention, are not acceptable. If in doubt, students should consult their House Leader or a member of Campus Leadership before making radical changes to hair. This includes but may not be limited to such hairstyles as mullets, dreadlocks, skullcuts, and undercuts.

Hair must be neat, clean, and tidy always at school. Hair colour must be within the natural range of colour for people.

Students cannot shave their head and hair length should not be shorter than a hairdresser's Number 2 cut.

All students are expected to be clean-shaven.

Students can expect that they will have to correct any issue with their hair as required by the College, and therefore, may miss time from school to have this done.

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Make up

1. A very light, barely visible foundation is the only make-up that will be accepted.
2. Acrylic, gel, or shellac nails are not permitted.
3. No eye make-up, no coloured nail polish or lipstick may be worn.
4. Eyelash extensions are not permitted.

Tattoos

Students are not permitted to obtain tattoos.

If a student has obtained a tattoo prior to enrolling at Cardijn, it must be covered at all times and needs to be identified at enrolment at the College.

Casual Day Dress Code

Throughout the year, there are a number of days where students are permitted to wear casual clothing. This might be for a fundraising day, camp, reflection day or other specific school activity. On such days, students are expected to dress in casual attire that is appropriate for a school environment, and which represents the values of the College in a positive manner. This means that outfits should include suitable enclosed footwear for practical subjects, such as Physical Education, Home Economics, Science and Technology. The clothing should not contain any offensive language or symbols and should not expose the student's midriff. Students should ensure they wear sun-safe attire where appropriate for the activities they are engaging in on the specific day.

Consequences for breaching this policy include:

1. Item(s) confiscated,
2. Removal from class or school until the breach is addressed/rectified,
3. Detention (lunch, after school, Saturday)

Continued breaches will result in:

4. Meeting with parents/caregivers
5. Ongoing suspension from classes

Cardijn College recognises that each Campus has specific uniform requirements in addition to those listed prior. These are outlined below.

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Cardijn Noarlunga Campus

In Terms 1 and 4 the Summer Uniform is to be worn and in Terms 2 and 3 the Winter Uniform is to be worn. Change over period is at the Principal's discretion.

Summer

Females

Dress	Button Front Dress. Cleolene (No 8125). Blue/Maroon on white background with white piping. Length: To the back of the knee when kneeling (minimum).
Shoes	Black leather dress shoes.
Socks	Plain white ankle socks – not low-cut anklets or sport socks.
Jumper/ Vest	Plain maroon jumper or vest with College crest. Year 12 Senior Blue Jumper with College crest may be worn by Year 12 students
Blazer	Maroon doctor flannel blazer with College crest. (Optional with summer uniform)

Males

Shirt	Short sleeved blue chambray shirt with Cardijn College embroidered over the pocket.
Tie	Optional in Summer. Maroon and yellow tie, or Year 12 Senior tie may be worn by students in Year 12.
Shorts	Mycron brand mid grey melange shorts (elastic backed or belt looped). Plain black leather belt with a small gold or silver buckle must be worn with the belt looped shorts.
Trousers	Mid grey melange trousers.
Jumper/ Vest	Plain maroon jumper or vest with College crest. Year 12 Senior Blue Jumper with College crest may be worn by Year 12 students
Shoes	Black leather dress shoes
Socks	Short plain grey socks (not low-cut anklets).
Blazer	Maroon doctor flannel blazer with College crest. (Optional with summer uniform)

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Winter

Females

Skirt	Cardijn College check skirt. Length: To the back of the knee when kneeling (minimum), but no longer than mid-calf length.
Trousers	Mid-grey pleat-fronted melange trousers.
Shirt	Short or long-sleeved blue chambray shirt with Cardijn College embroidered over the pocket.
Tie	To be worn with chambray shirt in Winter. Maroon and yellow tie, or Year 12 Senior tie may be worn by students in Year 12.
Jumper/ Vest	Plain maroon jumper or vest with College crest. Year 12 Senior Blue Jumper with College crest may be worn by Year 12 students
Blazer	Maroon doctor flannel blazer with College crest. (Blazers are compulsory for all students with winter uniform).
Shoes	Black leather dress shoes
Socks/ Pantyhose	Plain grey ankle socks (not low-cut anklets) with trousers, black opaque pantyhose with skirt.

Males

Trousers	Mid-grey melange trousers.
Shirt	Long sleeved blue chambray shirt with Cardijn College embroidered over the pocket.
Tie	To be worn with chambray shirt in Winter. Maroon and yellow tie, or Year 12 Senior tie may be worn by students in Year 12.
Jumper/ Vest	Plain maroon jumper or vest with College crest. Year 12 Senior Blue Jumper with College crest may be worn by Year 12 students
Blazer	Maroon doctor flannel blazer with College crest. (Optional with summer uniform)
Shoes	Black leather dress shoes
Socks	Short plain grey socks (not low-cut anklets).

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Sports Uniform

Shorts	Plain navy shorts with Cardijn College in gold on bottom hem, elastic waist. Male or female options with Kea brand.
Shirt	Blue polo shirt with Cardijn College in gold.
Shoes	Cross trainers.
Socks	Cardijn sports socks, or plain white socks.
Sports top	Striped rugby top with Cardijn College in gold
Sports Jacket	Navy spray jacket OR Navy fleece-lined, water-proof sports jacket
Tracksuit pants	Plain navy Microfibre track suit pants with Cardijn College in gold below pocket line.

Other attire

Hats	Navy blue cap or bucket hat with Cardijn logo to be worn with PE uniform when outdoors. A hat is compulsory in all PE lessons.
Bags	Navy backpack with Cardijn Logo, available from the College.
Winter Scarf	Navy only

Footwear ***Black sports shoes or black casual footwear such as Vans, Converse or black sneakers are not permitted and are not part of the summer or winter uniform. Shoes worn with the summer or winter uniform must be black leather dress shoes.***

Sneakers are not a part of the school uniform and must not be worn to and from school except on days when PE is scheduled. Students should wear sports shoes that appropriately support running and general activity as well as prevent injury. Casual shoes, such as Vans or Converse or skate shoes are not permitted.

Only on the days students have practical PE are they permitted to wear the full sports uniform of the school both to and from school.

Australian Army Cadets

Standard Cadet Uniform.

DPCU (Disruptive Pattern Camouflage Uniform) Australian Army issued trousers and shirt with the KFF slouch hat and/or DCPLU Bush hat for field exercises and activities.

Ceremonial Cadet Uniform.

DPCU (Disruptive Pattern Camouflage Uniform) trousers and shirt with KFF slouch hat and rising sun badge attached to the left side brim turned up. Black ceremonial belt with brass accessories.
